Access Services and Resource Sharing Special Interest Group (SIG)

Mandate:

To provide a forum for discussion and on-going learning and to offer direction on behalf of the Association in areas involving "traditional" technical services practices and resource sharing. This includes cataloguing standards/practices, acquisitions, serials control, interlibrary loan systems, initiatives and practices, and any other processes of this nature affecting Canadian law libraries.

The group also monitors the development, operation and use of bibliographic utilities and significant union catalogue initiatives in Canada and beyond, to ensure, as much as is possible, that the interests of Canadian law libraries and legal bibliography generally are being well served.

A member of this SIG acts as CALL's liaison with the Canadian Committee on Cataloguing.

In addition, this SIG has one subcommittee, the Subcommittee on Classification which replaces the KF Users' Group and also has assumed the responsibilities of the ISM/UTLAS Users' Group which has been dissolved.
